


Safety Card

Helicopter landing site	 <p>In case of an emergency we will mark the field above the home base with a X (yellow).</p> <p>In this case the official landing site is reserved as helicopter landing place (red). Landing there is strictly forbidden.</p> <p>Alternatively athletes will land on the official local landing site (blue)</p>

Safety Information	Important information during the race will be communicated through our Safety Chat
- Flight Ban	When issued, there is a strict start ban . Any athlete starting after this ban will be disqualified. Athletes flying at this time have to land as fast as possible, in consideration of their own safety
- Race Stop	When issued all athletes have to interrupt their race and wait for further information from the race director. Athletes flying at this time have to land as fast as possible, in consideration of their own safety and wait for further information
- Race Abortion	All athletes have to interrupt their race and return to the home base. Athletes flying at this time have to land as fast as possible, in consideration of their own safety, and return to the home base on foot. Athletes with a long distance to our home base will be collected by members of the organization.
Emergency - easy (Ankle...)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Talk to the injured athlete, make sure about its condition - Call the Race Director - Ambulance/Rega called by the Race Director or a member of the staff will transport the athlete to the home base/hospital
Emergency - severe	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Call 1414 - Call Race Director - First aid
